B.Ed. CONCURRENT

Taken at the same time as your undergraduate degree (B.A., B.B.A. or B.Sc.), this approach requires a minimum of 5 years to complete both degrees.

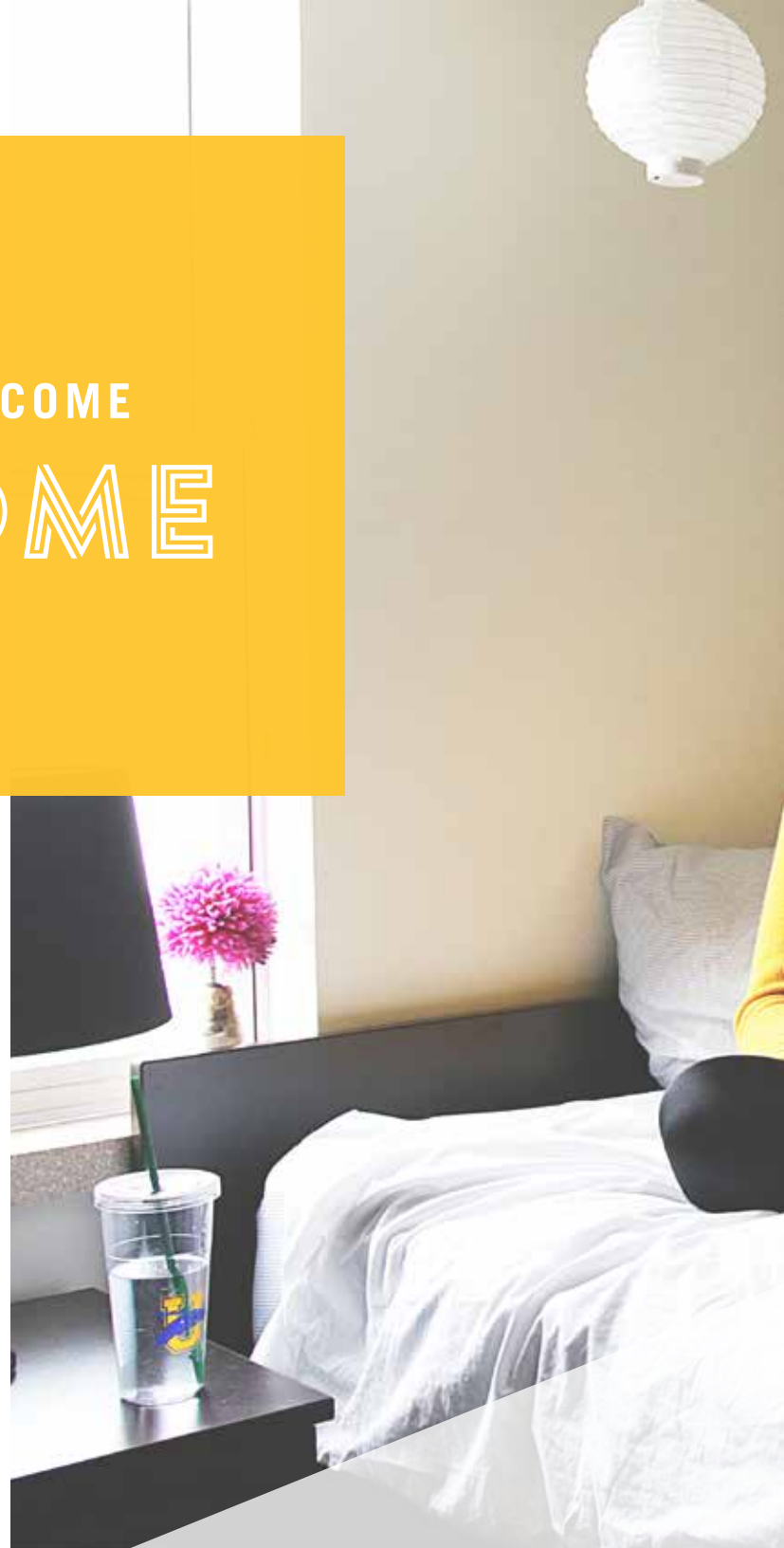

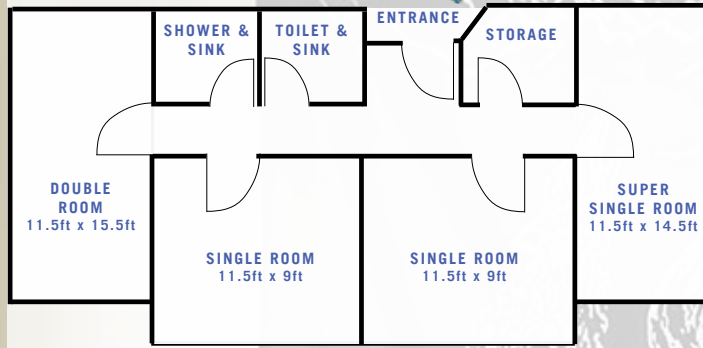

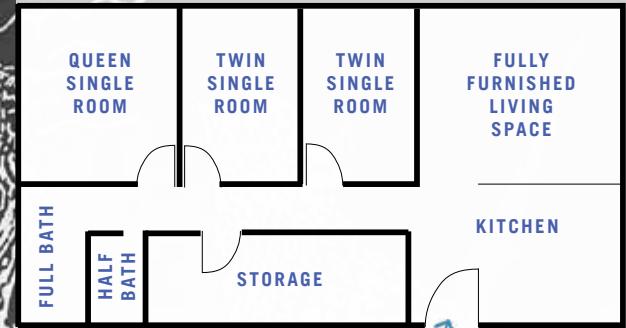


COLBURNE HOUSE RESIDENCE

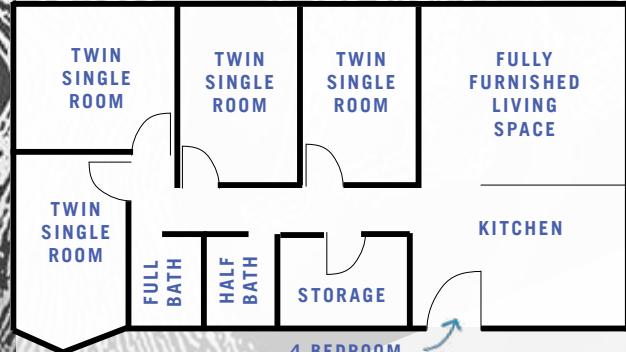


EXAMPLE OF A POD

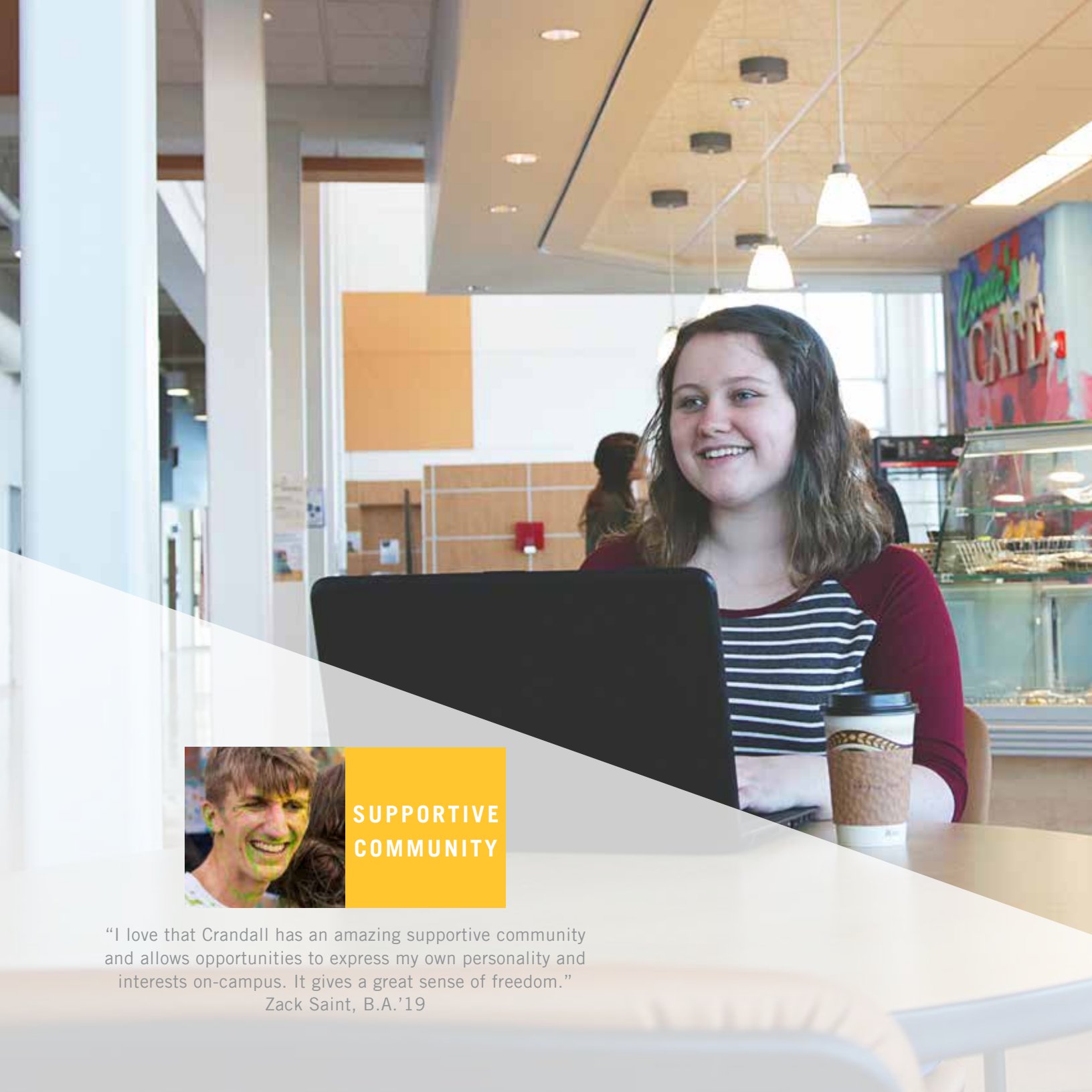

CRANDALL IS SITUATED ON A 200-ACRE CAMPUS IN THE BEAUTIFUL AND THRIVING CITY OF MONCTON, NEW BRUNSWICK, CANADA.

Moncton was recently deemed one of the safest cities in Canada. It is also one of the country's fastest growing cities, just a 20 minute drive from the warmest saltwater beaches north of Virginia, and an hour away from the magnificent natural wonders of the Fundy coastline.

THE EAST COAST

Canada's East Coast is one of the world's most popular tourist destinations. You will experience fresh air, unspoiled nature, and rich continental & natural history. Every season is beautiful and distinct and the climate allows us to enjoy the great outdoors all year long.

WHAT'S CLOSE BY

Did you know our quiet Campus is a short walk to one of the busiest streets in Moncton? With sit-in and fast-food restaurants, stores, churches, a pharmacy and coffee shops close by, you have access to many amenities.

We are also a short cab ride to cinemas, big-box shopping, one of the top zoo's in Canada, and more restaurants!

TRAVEL BY AIR
