Our women's fencing team placed 3rd at the 2015 National Intercollegiate **Women's Fencing Association** Championships (NIWFAC).



#### Special Programs of Interest

#### Pre-University Program (PUP):

Students who meet the University's academic requirements for the major of their choice and who have an intermediate level of English proficiency may be considered for admission to the PUP. The English proficiency level required for PUP admission is determined by one of the following:

- 1. TOEFL IBT score from 68 to 78
- 2. IELTS overall band score of 5.5
- 3. An ELS Language Center Certificate of Completion of Level 110 of the English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program. (For more information, visit **els.edu**.)

PUP students take academic courses while improving their English language skills, earning up to 11 credits toward their bachelor's degree. This innovative structure affords PUP students the potential to complete a bachelor's degree in just four years.

#### Accelerated B.S. & Doctor of Pharmacy Program:
